

An ongoing outreach program of St John in the Wilderness Anglican Church is serving at the Inn of the Good Shepherd.

On the first Saturday of each month for the past 20 years, volunteers from St John's have served the evening meal at the Soup Kitchen at the Inn.

If you would like to help, the signup sheet is in the Church Hall.

Serving the meal generally requires 8-12 volunteers, who prepare the food in their own homes then meet at the Inn to serve the meal. Usually the volunteers on the sign up sheet discuss beforehand what is to be served and how much each person will bring.

Often the meal is meatloaf, baked potatoes, mixed vegetables and buns.

Adults teens and children are all welcome to volunteer, its a great way for a high school student to get their volunteer hours.

We usually meet at the Inn at 3:45 PM to prepare. Mealtimes is 4:30- 5:30 PM.

Cleanup requires 20-30 minutes and we are usually done by 6 PM at the latest.
