The chairs for Amanda's office are on order. The South Hall windows are also on order and will arrive in 5-6 weeks. Installation of the South Hall windows will be scheduled after the windows have arrived. The church's higher south windows have been measured and ordered. Electrical kitchen upgrade completed today. This will allow for many items to be plugged in together without tripping the electrical breakers. (Example: Pancake grills.) Hall Floor was deep cleaned about 3 weeks ago. Shed

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ramp now installed. Dehumidifier Hall drain to be installed. March 15, 2024

Treasurer's Report

Expenses are above plan since we are in the winter season. Envelopes are short about 3.4% of budget. Currently \$17,000 in bank but we will need to also use the memorial funds to cover many capital expenses already mentioned in the Property Committee Report. There was a conversation to spread apportionment to help cash flow. This may be implemented if needed. One final note is that we have received our insurance amount for 2024 and it is slightly less than we had budgeted for.
